

## **Membership Eligibility**

Legion membership is open to any Canadian citizen or citizen of an Allied nation who is 18 years of age or older.

### MISSION STATEMENT

### **Categories of membership**

There are four main categories of membership:

#### **Ordinary Membership**

Includes still serving and retired military, reservists, NATO, RCMP, R.N.F. Constabulary, all provincial or municipal police officers, Canadian Coast Guard, Wartime Allied Force Underground Force, NORAD, Service in US Force, Vietnam, Cadet Instructor Cadre (CIC) Non-military

#### **Associate Membership**

Includes parents, spouses, widows, widowers, children, grandchildren, siblings, nieces as well as nephews of a person who is or was eligible for Ordinary membership.

Or

The child, spouse, sibling of an Associate member of any Command/Branch of the Royal Canadian Legion in good standing.

#### **Affiliate Voting Membership**

Includes Canadian citizens or Commonwealth subjects from an Allied nation who support The Royal Canadian Legion's aims and objectives and are not eligible for ordinary or associate membership.

#### **Affiliate Non-voting Membership**

Includes non-Canadian citizens or non-Commonwealth subjects from an Allied nation who support The Royal Canadian Legion's aims and objectives.
